







<p>Shape of the land</p>  <p>Distance from water</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Certain land formations (mountains and valleys) can affect the movement of air masses which affect the weather conditions a region experiences</li> <li>• Land and Sea breezes are local convection currents that occur in areas near water because of the unequal heating of Earth materials</li> </ul>
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<p>Global winds</p>  <p>Ocean currents</p> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• provide a predictable pattern for the movement of air in a specific region and are named after the direction they come from</li> <li>• circulate heat energy</li> <li>• Air masses that originate over regions of the ocean are moved with currents and affect the climate of coastal regions</li> </ul>
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
